ENVIRONMENT MATTERS

(Les Webb): June 17-18th

This two day course gives an introduction to the current legislation and an overview of industry best practice. The course is designed to give a thorough introduction to the key issues in the environmental area.

OPTIMISING WATER CLOSE-UP AT PAPER MILLS

This seminar is aimed at production and technical staff at mills and their suppliers who want to gain an insight into the motivations/problems and the different technical approaches involved in closing up mill water systems, which is an important aspect within Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control. This can only be done by bringing together the quality, engineering, chemical and biological aspects of the total machine/mill operation.

OPTIMISING WASTEWATER TREATMENT AT PAPER MILLS

This seminar is aimed at anyone involved in the design and operation of mill treatment plants from operators to production/technical staff, including suppliers of treatment plant and chemicals. The emphasis is on practical aspects of plant operation with a view to improving understanding and overall plant performance and on the more recent process developments within each treatment category.

THE PITA COATING COURSE

(Ian Davis): July 16-17th: Central Scotland

This 2 day course gives a thorough background to the coating process. Subjects covered include raw materials, coating mixes and application equipment. The critical areas of rheology, drying and calendering and troubleshooting of real life coating problems are also covered.
