The Role

To support the Head of Regulatory Affairs in managing CPI's activities regarding energy and environmental legislation and policy, with an immediate emphasis on current and future energy issues, including climate change and emissions trading. One major responsibility (after appropriate training) will be the day-to-day management of the paper manufacturing sector's Climate Change Agreement. This role necessitates overseeing the monthly collection and annual external audit of our industry's energy consumption data in order to monitor and assess performance against energy reduction targets agreed with UK Government.

The Candidate

You will have a demonstrable grasp of the complexities and the potential consequences of the energy and environmental agenda as it impacts on the competitiveness of UK manufacturing industry. A background in engineering or energy management - particularly at a paper mill - would be useful although this is by no means essential. You are numerate and comfortable with analysis and interpretation of spreadsheets; a result-oriented team player, you are also able to liaise and influence at all levels within an organisation. You are likely to be educated to degree level and may have had experience in a similar role with direct involvement in energy/environmental/regulatory issues.

Location

Although based in west Swindon, CPI supports flexible working arrangements and will encourage home-based working to the extent possible within the requirements of the job. For practical reasons, it is envisaged that any home-based location will be within two hours' travel of the Swindon-Reading M4 corridor.
